- **Some** miscellaneous provincial statute charges

During the month of June 2017, the Midland Police generated 802 incident reports in response to community needs. This is up from 789 incidents during the same time period in 2016. Incident reports generated to date for 2017 stand at 3809 as compared to 4206 for 2016.

CRIMINAL OFFENCES

Theft Under \$5,000

There were (22) thefts reported to the Midland Police Service in the month of June. Of the (22) thefts reported, (4) were cleared through investigation or charges. The balance are under investigation.

The clearance rate for thefts this month is (18%).

Mischief

There were (4) mischiefs reported to the Service this month. (1) was cleared by charge.

The clearance rate is (25%)

Break and Enter

A total of (6) break and enters were reported to the Service in June. These matters are under investigation.

Fraud

A total of (8) frauds were reported to the Service in June. (2) were cleared through investigation or charge. The balance are under investigation.

The clearance rate is (25%).

Many of the frauds reported are scams that are occurring across the province and Canada.

Assault

There were (4) assaults reported to the Service in the month of June. All (4) assault calls that were cleared through investigation or charge.

The clearance rate is (100%).

Criminal Harassment/Threats

There were (0) harassment matters reported to the service in the month of June.

A total of (1) threatening case was reported to the Midland Police Service during the month of June. The Service cleared it by investigation or charge.

Clearance rate (100%)

Drug Offences

A total of (5) drug related charges were laid by Midland officers in the month of June with (2) persons being charged.

Impaired Driving-Over 80mgs

A total of (1) related charge was laid.

VCARS referrals:

There were (3) referrals to the Victim Crisis and Referral Service in the month of June.

RIDE/Foot Patrol:

During the month of June, Midland officers conducted a total of (30) hours of RIDE. A total of (866) vehicles were stopped by Midland officers this month. A total of (8) traffic cautions were issued. No impaired drivers were detected by officers.

In addition, a total of (73) hours of foot patrol was conducted in our high visibility locations, including the downtown area, Rotary Trail, NSSRC and others.

Auxiliary Hours

(101) hours of service which included; general patrol with uniformed officers and foot patrol.

COMMUNITY SERVICE:

Constable Chris Paul, was re-assigned to the Criminal Investigations Branch for the summer as all school programs were completed

During the month of July 2017, the Midland Police generated 945 incident reports in response to community needs. This is up from 859 incidents during the same time period in 2016. Incident reports generated to date for 2017 stand at 4756 as compared to 5065 for 2016.

CRIMINAL OFFENCES

Theft Under \$5,000

There were (22) thefts reported to the Midland Police Service in the month of July. Of the (22) thefts reported, (1) was cleared through investigation or charge.

Clearance rate (4%)

Several thefts reported this month were petty theft and theft of cellular telephones that were left un-secured

Mischief

There were (6) mischiefs reported to the Service this month. (2) of these mischiefs were cleared by investigation or charge.

Clearance rate (33%)

Break and Enter

There were (3) break and enters reported to the Service this month. All matters are under investigation.

Fraud

A total of (5) frauds were reported to the Service in July. The majority of these frauds were on-line and telephone scams which are prevalent in all countries.

Robbery

There was (1) report of a Robbery to the Service in the month of July. This case was cleared by investigation/charge.

Clearance rate (100%)

Assault

There were (5) assaults reported to the Service in the month of July. (4) were cleared through investigation or charge.

The clearance rate is (80%).

Sexual Assault

There was (1) historic sexual assault report made to the Service in the month of July. This matter is under investigation.

Criminal Harassment/Threats

A total of (1) harassment complaint was made to the service this month. It was cleared by discretion/diversion.

Clearance rate: (100%)

A total of (2) threatening cases were reported to the Midland Police Service during the month of July. The Service cleared (1) by investigation or charge.

Clearance rate (50%)

Drug Offences

A total of (1) drug related charges were laid by Midland officers in the month of July with (1) persons being arrested.

Impaired Driving-Over 80mgs

A total of (3) related charges were laid against (2) people.

Discretion/Diversions/Alternative Measures – YCJA/Other:

There was (1) criminal matters diverted/alternative measures in the month of July.

VCARS referrals:

There were (10) referrals to the Victim Crisis and Referral Service in the month of July.

RIDE/Foot Patrol:

During the month of July, Midland officers conducted a total of (28) hours of RIDE. A total of (610) vehicles were stopped by Midland officers this month. A total of (2) traffic cautions were issued. No impaired drivers were detected by officers.

In addition, a total of (72) hours of foot patrol was conducted in our high visibility locations, including the downtown area, Rotary Trail, NSSRC and others.

Auxiliary Hours

(37) hours of service which included; general patrol with uniformed officers and foot patrol.

During the month of August 2017, the Midland Police generated 748 incident reports in response to community needs. This is down from 798 incidents during the same time period in 2016. Incident reports generated to date for 2017 stand at 5504 as compared to 5863 for 2016.

CRIMINAL OFFENCES

Theft Under \$5,000

There were (22) thefts reported to the Midland Police Service in the month of August. (6) of them were cleared through investigation/charge.

Clearance rate (30%)

The majority of thefts were a result of property being left un-secured.

Mischief

There were (7) mischief's reported to the Service this month. (1) of these mischief's was cleared by investigation or charge and (1) was cleared by discretion/diversion.

Clearance rate (28%)

Break and Enter

There were three break and enters reported to the service this month. They are under investigation

Fraud

A total of (4) frauds were reported to the Service in August. These were internet or phone scams.

Assault

There were (6) assaults reported to the Service in the month of August. Of the (6) assault calls that were reported, (4) were cleared through investigation or charge and (2) were cleared through discretion/diversion.

The clearance rate is (100%).

Assault with a Weapon

There was (1) assault with a weapon call this month. It was cleared through investigation/charge.

Clearance rate (100%)

Criminal Harassment/Threats

A total of (1) harassment complaint was made to the service this month. It was cleared by discretion/diversion.

Clearance rate: (100%)

A total of (3) threatening cases were reported to the Midland Police Service during the month of August. The Service cleared (3) by discretion or diversion.

Clearance rate (100%)

Impaired Driving-Over 80mgs

A total of (6) related charges were laid against (3) people.

Discretion/Diversions/Alternative Measures – YCJA/Other:

There were (7) criminal matters diverted/alternative measures in the month of August.

VCARS referrals:

There were (3) referrals to the Victim Crisis and Referral Service in the month of August.

RIDE/Foot Patrol:

During the month of August, Midland officers conducted a total of (34) hours of RIDE. A total of (1216) vehicles were stopped by Midland officers this month. A total of (7) traffic caution was issued. A total of (2) traffic charges were laid. No impaired drivers were detected by officers.

In addition, a total of (63) hours of foot patrol was conducted in our high visibility locations, including the downtown area, Rotary Trail, NSSRC and others.

Auxiliary Hours

(52) hours of service which included; general patrol with uniformed officers and foot patrol.
